Registration open for BWC's workplace safety and health conference

COLUMBUS – Registration is now open for the [Ohio Safety Congress & Expo \(OSC 2020\)](#) hosted by the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation (BWC).

OSC 2020 is the largest regional safety and health conference in the U.S. and will run March 11-13 at the Greater Columbus Convention Center. BWC is also offering an online attendance option – a live broadcast of select sessions and reports from the event that customers can access from anywhere.
